Please register your poster data in advance.

All of the registered poster data will be freely viewable only for 120JDA participants only during meeting, from June 10 at 8:30am to June 13 at 5:00pm.

【Question-and-answer session】

Questions from participants will be sent to your email address which you registered in advance by "MICEnavi" system. Please answer as much as possible.

【How to register your Digital Poster】

We will send the presenters your ID, password and URL to log in to the Digital Poster registration site before registration starts.

Digital poster registration period:

April 28, 2021 (Wed) to May 21, 2021 (Fri) noon (Japan standard time)

* Please note that we do not accept registrations or corrections after the above registration period.

* It is expected that access will be concentrated near the deadline, so please register as soon as possible.

* If we do not receive your digital poster data by deadline, your abstract will be automatically withdrawn.

【Instruction】

Basically, please prepare your digital poster with PowerPoint slides. However, if you wish, you can use the PowerPoint with narration and register as a video. You can also upload a video in MP4 format. Please register by the method you prefer when registering.

- All speakers must disclose any COI (Conflict of Interest) on your poster data.
- Please prepare title slide including poster number, title, author's name, affiliation.

<PPT registration (no sounds and animation)>

- Please prepare your presentation data within 20 slides (including title and COI slide) and 100MB or less.
- Please prepare your presentation data MS PowerPoint^{*1, *2}.

<Video registration>

- Please prepare your presentation data within 20 slides (including title and COI slide) and 1GB or less and within 5 minutes of presentation.
- Please register the presentation slides in MS PowerPoint file format with narration ^{*1, *2} or MP4.

If you make your presentation data by Keynote, please check your data (character skew etc.) after changing to MS PowerPoint.

- Please refrain from writing in note area of your slide.
